Comments on Emergency Communications Tower Cooks Butte

Dear Johanna,

The following comments are based on my review of the plans;

- 1. Arborvitae is NOT appropriate in our natural area, screening needs to native plant material, planted in a natural random pattern. Screening needs to be robust.
- 2. Oregon Grape should not be planted as a screening shrub and the screening material needs to be planted in a natural random pattern. Screening along driveway will create problematic blind spots, promoting illegal activity.
- 3. Douglas Fir mitigation (2) are in inappropriate locations, mitigation monitoring needs to be required.
- 4. The height of the surrounding coniferous trees needs to be determined and an accurate visual needs to be supplied prior to approval.
- 5. All native plants that are removed as part of the project need to be mitigated.
- 6. Plans should be presented to citizen Parks, Recreation and Natural Resource Advisory Board for review, the Board has not been consulted with at this point in the process.
- 7. On sheet 2 it appears more trees will need to be removed than indicated on sheet A 2.0, they need to be reconciled.
